Never fear, you can sponsor hats for our project:

Linda and Jamie talked about knitting hats for the military in Afghanistan and Iraq and completely independently Two Sisters & Ewe had ordered some cool Camo superwash wool - the perfect yarn our hat project! We (with the help of our friendly community of knitters and crocheters) will be knitting/crocheting and collecting hats over the next few months for delivery to our troops in Afghanistan.

For those who already knit/crochet in East County San Diego, you can purchase a skein of SRK Trenton Worsted (or add a skein of complimentary color for a great multi-colored design making "Hats from Home" uniquely you) at Two Sisters & Ewe. If you are out of the area, you can use any superwash worsted weight wool\* in plain old military colors (brown, black, dark blue, tan, dark green or gray) or combination of said colors (what the heck, make up your own version of camo) to create your hat.

And for those who haven't yet been bitten by the knitting bug - please sponsor a knitter! The Camo yarn at Two Sisters is very reasonable - for \$6.00 you can sponsor a "Hat from Home" to be knitted locally. All our handmade hats will be sent with a card giving the name of the sponsor and the name of the knitter (we also encourage you to take a picture of knitter/sponsor/hat and we will print that and include it with the hat as well).



In a nutshell, sponsor a hat and/or knit a hat, drop it off at Two Sisters & Ewe or contact us for other collection options.... we will package them and get them to the troops in Afghanistan.
